‘Just, Democratic and Secular Society’.

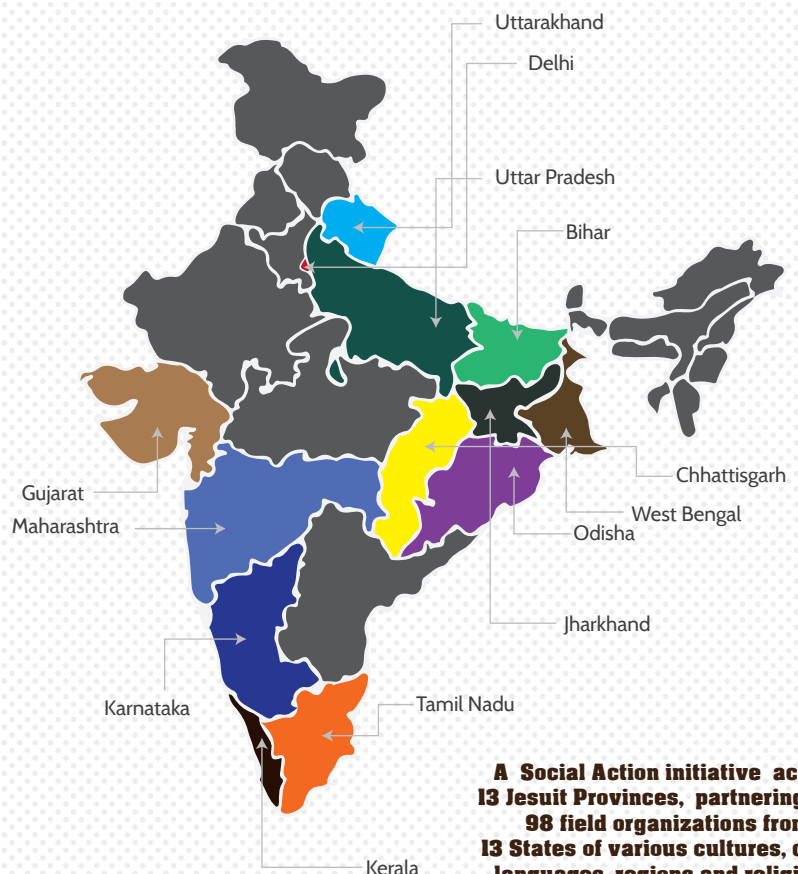
