ADILABAD - ASIFABAD MISSION:

Our dream is that no tribal child remains at home without going to school in the academic year 2021-'22. We made three visits to all 13 villages from Irrupaguda to Jodeghat, met the children and parents and motivated them to move to schools as soon as they are reopened. We have enlisted the services of the teachers to get all the students into schools. In order to make teaching – learning process interesting, we have ordered a set of charts and maps for Maths, Science, Social Studies and language subjects to each of the 6 schools where our students would be learning. Works on the computer lab at Jodeghat School will be completed by 10th Apr. We will also give one set of new dress for every school going child from Irrupaguda to Jodeghat. We hope



that all these incentives will motivate the children to learn well. We addressed class 10 students of our Hatti, ITDA School three times during Mar and we will accompany and assist them till they begin the public exams.

Frs. Pratap and Amalraj accompanied the Bishop to Gopalpurthanda in Lingapur mandal to find a suitable place for the construction of a small multipurpose centre for the Christians of Lambada community. On the same day he visited all our villages in which we are working. The Bishop commissioned us again to go there on 17th and we were shown a new place by the people. It will take some time to finalize the place to purchase it. Fr Xavier Rex was one of the main organizers for the mega spiritual event of the clergy, religious and laity on 19th Mar





at CPC Gadderegadi as the Year of St. Joseph was inaugurated and his feast was celebrated. He invited Fr. PR John SJ the principal Vidya Jyoti College, Delhi as the resource person of the day. Fr. John's Spirit filled and inspiring talk on St. Joseph was appreciated and cherished by the entire audience. Fr. Xavier Rex also organized the birth day celebrations of Fr. 
