On 26th July, the Supreme Court has issued a notice and stayed the judgement passed by the High Court against the Jesuit Educational and Charitable Society of Wayanad - a case filed against the minority rights of Jesuit Management by a former teacher.

TUDI distributed 600 dry food & non-food kits and 100 medical kits to Tribal Covid patients as well as other deserving group of people in our neighbours Grama-Panchayats of Wayanad district with the help of our Assistancy, ISI-Delhi and KJS.


