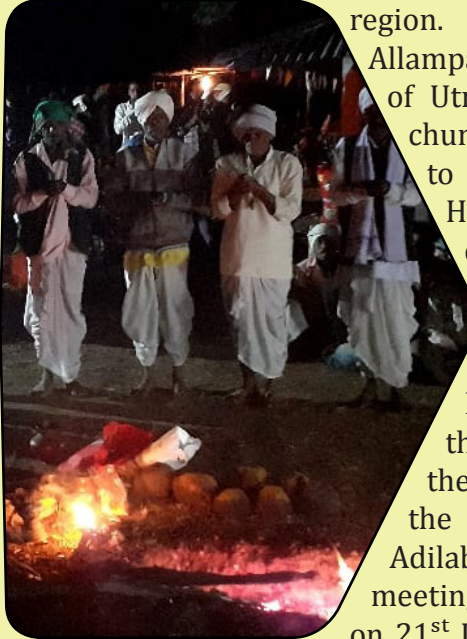
ADILABAD - ASIFABAD MISSION:

Christmas gift and exchanged the gift with one another. They sang carols. The guest of honour was the President of People's Action Forum Dr. P. Suresh. He spoke women's right and civil society activism. Fr. Anil Francis gave the Christmas message

inspiring all of them how the triune God intended to dwell among us and wants us to be united in all our joys and sorrows. Fr. Selvin distributed Rs. 20,000 each as loan to 12 MCU women members of Kakarlamudi village and 6 catechists of Pedana Parish. We exchanged sweets, cake and pleasantries.

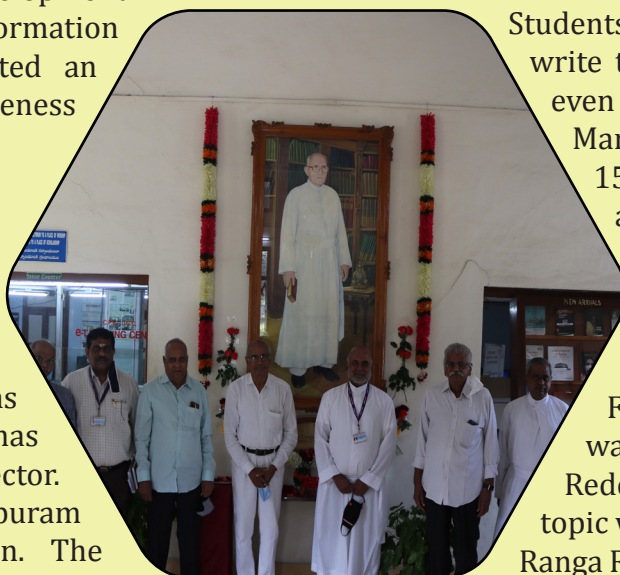
LOYOLA INSTITUTIONS, VIJAYAWADA:

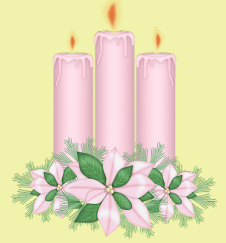
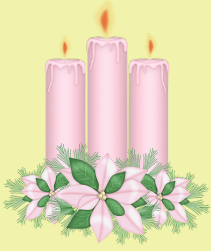
