ADILABAD - ASIFABAD MISSION:

We began the Advent Season on 29th Nov 2020 with Lenten practices to prepare ourselves for the feast of Christmas. The winter has set in with its biting cold. In memory of the Holy Babe of Bethlehem covered with swaddling clothes, we distributed 101 blankets for the expectant mothers and lactating mothers on Jodeghat Hills. We are grateful to our Bishop Prince Anthony for this gift. There was a Pre-Christmas



celebration at Parish level in Utnoor on 15th Dec. The Bishop gave a thought provoking message and the children of Adilabad and Utnoor entertained the congregation with their songs and dances. The youth of the parish sang their prize-winning song, sung at the Jingle Bell competition 2020 in Mancherial. This celebration was preceded by the Christmas celebration of all consecrated people (priests and religious) working in the diocese on 11th and it was followed by the Christmas celebration of the











local CRI unit of Adilabad diocese on 22nd. This CRI get together was organized by Fr Xavier Rex the president of the local CRI unit of Adilabad diocese. It was well attended by about 110 religious priests, brothers, sisters, novices and candidates. Fr Joshy the CMI Provincial of Hyderabad province enlightened the participants on the content of "Fratelli Tutti" and Fr Amal spoke on the vision and mission of CRI. Fr Pratap sang a solo Christmas song. The post card campaign for the release of Fr Stan Swamy and his 15 other companions was launched in this meeting at Adilabad level. He also organized a Semi-Christmas

celebration for all the staff of Carmel Academy consisting of both the Telugu and English Medium Schools and Junior College on 23rd. The teaching and non-teaching staff thoroughly enjoyed the celebration as it had singing, party games, sharing of gifts and dinner with Christmas cake. He distributed dry food ration and a blanket each to 50 poor families in four villages to celebrate Christmas with joy.

Frs Amal and Pratap spent two days in Satyodayam for the submission of accounts of "Red Charity, Austria" Project and participation in the Social Action Commission meeting. They were busy from 16th, leading the Christmas carol group to each catholic house in Utnoor. Fr Amal together with little children prepared a crib in front of our house. Fr Pratap gave final touches to it fixing the lights and stars. The catholic youth of the Utnoor parish prepared a Mega Crib with a lot of creativity to proclaim the Lord's birth. We have planned to have Christmas mid night Mass with an hour of adoration preceding it. Since all the parishioners have chosen their Christmas friends, there will be also exchange of gifts after the Mass.

In the history of Utnoor Catholic Church, 20th Dec has been an unforgettable day. Since 1987, it had remained as mission centre and not a parish as per Syro Malabar Church. It was raised to the status of a parish to the joy of the people, with the reading of the decree of Bishop Prince Antony by Fr Jose, the Vicar General and administering the oath to two trustees elected by the elders of Utnoor catholic community. The appointment of Fr Tom as the parish priest was also read out. We are awaiting the arrival of our candidates from Karimnagar with Fr MA. Alex their superior and Fr Maria Prasad their in-charge on 29th at Carmel

Mandamarri and St. Paul's Utnoor. They would visit an open mine and Carmel academy at Mandamarri, our residence and area of operation at Utnoor and the memorial and museum of Kumram Bheem, the martyr of Gond's, who fought for the rights of Adivasi on Jal, Jungle and Jameen. JESUIT SCHOOL MEN MEET:

On 19th Dec, the Coordinator of School Education, Fr KP. Francis, arranged one day seminar cum sharing on the National Educational Policy-2020 (NEP) and its implementation. The coordinator informed all well in advance and it was well represented. The resource persons were: Dr. K. Geetha Rao, Rtd. Professor, member of UGC, NCERT, and board member of OU, Hyderabad and Dr. Bala kumar, the Principal of Pasha College of Education, Hyderabad, NACC accreditation member, coordinator of TS Govt. SES (School Education Syllabus) and SEC (School Education Commission). They explained about NEP and its implementation processes. In their opinion this might take about 10 years approximately. Both took an hour each to explain to us how this NEP is going to be implemented. They also humbly accepted the difficulties and shortcomings in executing in our multi cultural, diverse but one country. Some of the participants posed relevant, practical and pertinent questions to take the talks to a deeper level. Fr Arul Jothi proposed vote of thanks to our resource persons.

The sharing session in the afternoon was ably moderated by Fr Simon. The parameters given for sharing include; 1. The situation of our school last year and present academic year, how do you manage Salary, fee collection etc. today? 2. How have we been implementing the UAP's (Universal Apostolic Preferences) in our schools? 3. How do we inculcate important values like peace, harmony, reconciliation, secularism and democracy among our students, staff and parents? 4. Major difficulties or struggles that we have in our institutions. 5. What are some of the plans, vision or suggestions that we have for our schools? There were few concerns consisting of both general concerns and particular. The concerns are quality in terms of standard of the students and staff also the salary, school strength, attractive allurements of the Governments, etc. They were taken into consideration by the school men commission after the sharing. At the end Fr Avinash thanked everyone for their kind and generous cooperation and collaboration. Indeed the seminar was meaningful and informative for many.


మహిళలు పాదుపు అలవాటుగా మార్చుకోవాలి

LOYOLA ACADEMY, SECUNDERABAD:




