I am given ample opportunities by the Parish Priest to Break the Word of God for the people. The feast of 'Our Lady of Lourdes' on Feb 11th was a blessing for me. It gave me a lot of confidence to go ahead in this pastoral ministry. This Parish began its existence in the year 1939. The new church was inaugurated in the year 2000. This particular Parish was closed from Jun - Oct 2019. After finishing his doctoral studies in Canon Law in Rome, Fr. Arulappa David in Oct 2019 was appointed as the Parish Priest. Slowly things are coming back to normal. There are still many wounds to be healed and it can flare up any moment. We are very much focusing only on the spiritual matters of the Parish. There is a lot of devotion in the people for the Eucharist and all other spiritual matters. In this season of Lent we are trying

our best to heal the differences among the people. I know it's not going to be an easy task. We are taking one day at a time. In this season of Lent we have daily Eucharist at 6.30 am, The Way of the Cross at 12.00 pm, Rosary at 5.30 pm followed by The Way of the Cross for all those who could not attend in the afternoon and Eucharistic Adoration at 9.00 pm. Nowhere I have seen or heard especially in the season of Lent having The Way of the Cross and the Eucharistic Adoration every day. Only in this Parish there is so much of devotion. It is astonishing to see the faithful participate actively in all the devotions every day.

This Parish has 320 families in the record but only 180 families come to the church regularly and pay the monthly subscription. Thanks to Fr. Antony Prabhu SJ who went around collecting the data during the house visits during his ministry here. He sent me the data and I shall take it forward by updating it. This Parish has three substations namely: Chukalur, Avulathippayapalle and Kallur. Fr. Stephen Amalraj SJ was the main celebrant for the annual

feast of Infant Jesus celebrated in the Chukalur substation on 14th Feb. People are very much interested in the church activities. contribute Thev generously for all the occasions. Everyday there is someone or the other who sponsors the 'Prasadam' that is distributed after the Eucharistic Adoration. Everv Sunday people come forward to do the 'Annadanam' for all the downtrodden and the poor found on the roadsides. I heard that during the Corona pandemic the Parish people went out of their way to feed the hungry everyday for nearly forty five days with their own contributions. There is a lot of goodwill and also painful conflicts that is pulling them apart. I pray for the people here that God give them the forgiveness by which they give up their mean human differences. We have planned for the Prayer and Healing meetings on 2 - 4 Mar. Fr. Arulappa is taking care of me in a good manner. We both are focusing mainly on the spiritual aspects and the rest we leave it to the Divine Will. I hope and pray our prayers and efforts bear fruit in healing the minds and hearts of the people here.

The season of Jataras for the tribals of Ummadi Adilabad district commenced from mid Jan. "Jangu Bai" Jatara began with "Devve Niruswal" (lighting the lamp) representing the deity at the cave temple in Maharajguda hamlet under Kotaparandoli village of Kerameri Mandal. There was Maha Puja, Bheting, introduction of the new daughter-in-laws to the deity, village fair, Betal Puja etc. during the festival. It is important for us working with Gonds and Kolams to attend these Jataras and express our solidarity with them. Thus we develop also our relationship and contact with them.

The season of Lent for us has commenced on 15th Feb with Ash Monday as per the tradition of Syro-Malabar Church. Since then, we have evening Mass in our parish church so that as many faithful as possible could attend it. It is very encouraging that many attend the daily Mass.

CITRA, SECUNDERABAD:



During the third week of Jan Fr. Selvin made a visit to Seethampeta to spend a few days there to monitor and take stock of the MCU operation after a prolonged lockdown. As he enjoyed the hospitality of Fr. Jayaseelan, he introduced Fr. Javaseelan to the functioning of MCU in 8 tribal villages of

Seethampeta. During the Covid-19 pandemic and the continual lockdown the members of MCU were not able to come together periodically, yet there was no backlog in returning the loan amount. The returned loan amount was re-distributed to 149 tribal families Rs.10, 000 each for the purpose of agriculture and goat/sheep breeding. The surplus amount Rs. 78,000 was utilized to buy 10 steel tables, 150 plastic chairs and one shamiana for their village use. All the MCU leaders deserve our appreciation and they will continue the good works with the advice and direction of Fr. Jayaseelan.

On 23rd Jan 10 families in Rayapalli who belong to the families of Toddy tappers received Rs. 10,000 each as loans through MCU. They are all non-Christians but economically poor. On the same day 10 more families in Vuyuru also received Rs. 10,000 each as loans through MCU. We appreciate Mr. Naresh a senior AICUFer for taking initiative to form the 2nd Unit of MCU there.



On 15th Feb, by the invitation of the Arch Bishop Poola Antony DD, Fr. Selvin attended the General Body meeting of ATCBC Social Forum at HASSS at Secunderabad.

On 7th and 21st Feb with the help of Mrs. Prabha an eye specialist from Eluru, CITRA conducted Free Eye-Camp in Manginepudi, Kothapudi, Rayapalli and Usalavaripalem coastal villages of Andhra Pradesh. Many elderly people had free eye-checkup. Around 200 reading glasses were distributed to the poor and elderly people.
