The value of regaining the spirit of concentration, awareness and mental tenor to stay focused has again become crucial. A goldfish in an aquarium has an attention span of eight seconds while a mobile addict has an attention span of only seven seconds! This I picked up from a dialogue in a recent film. It is instructive to listen to a Ted-talk on concentration by Dandapani, a young monk. Try to Google it.



NEWS FROM SERBIA AND ROME

The voyage to Europe began on the day of the Ignatian feast, when information about "Croatian Jesuits in Serbia" was obtained. Our heartfelt thanks the communities of St. Xavier's Thumba and SM farm Pariyaram where we had our interim stay. We left India for Serbia on August 12th. We stayed in St Peter's Parish, a Jesuit parish in Belgrade, Serbia. The hospitality provided by the Jesuits, namely **Frs Marijan Steiner, Smiljan Milicevic** and **Josip Opat**, was remarkable.

Serbia is a nation in Southeast Europe (Balkan Peninsula). According to the Serbian Census, there are now 84.6 percent Orthodox Christians, 5% Catholics, 3.1 percent Muslims, 1.1 percent atheists, 1% Protestants, 3.1 percent do not identify themselves confessionally, and about 2% other confessions. Saint Ignatius must have known about Belgrade because his nephew was martyred protecting the Belgrade City. In the eighties of the sixteenth century, Father Bartol Sfondrati of Dubrovnik, who joined the Society of Jesus when St Ignatius was still alive, travelled to Serbia. The wellknown Fr Bartol Kai arrived in Belgrade in the early 17th century. The first grammar school in Belgrade was established in 1613 by a group of Jesuits. In 1718, the superior of the community received the picture of Mary Help of Passau in Bavaria, subsequently known as the Virgin of Belgrade. She is still held in high regard, particularly on the 19th of every month and on her birthday, October 19th.

On 27 August morning, we left for Rome, where we were received by **Fr Keith Abranches**, the Rector of Gesu, and **Fr Gonzalo Silva Merino**, the Minister. We're now busy learning Italian.
