



1. IGNATIAN SPIRITUALITY COMMISSION

- Fr. Vimal Kishore, SJ

FOR JESUITS:

- 1. 20th of every month to be observed as special day: Community Mass, adoration, prayer service, reflection on Ignatian theme etc. would be held in community.
- 2. Recollections: Every month recollection talks (on different apostolates) will be prepared and sent to the communities for reflection, prayer and community sharing / spiritual conversation etc.
- 3. Sharing of "Cannon Ball Moments" (conversion) Experience by Jesuits especially Senior Jesuits in the province and to be published in Province News Letter
- 4. An 8 day Retreat organized at Atmadarshan for Jesuits every month
- 5. A Three days recollection / sharing with novitiate / ordination batch mates (Optional)
- 6. Souvenir prepared: book marks or cups (May 2022)
- 7. Quiz organised by Ignatian team (In July 2022)
- 8. Ignatian Spirituality Resource centre to be established in the province whose services all ministries can benefit from.
- 9. Implementation of minimum standards of safeguarding of minors and vulnerable adults in the Society of Jesus and in our institutions (Fr. General's letter on 13 May 2021).

FOR STAFF AND COLLABORATORS:


- 1. Workshops for staff members of our institutions on Ignatian themes, Methods of discernment, examine etc. (As and when convenient for the institutions).
- 2. Flexes on stages of conversion and spiritual experiences of St. Ignatius will be prepared and supplied to institutions to be displayed by Ignatian team by July (if there is no lockdown).
- 3. For students: Examine, Discernment, Ignatian hymns

 - Include Ignatian themes in Sunday homilies


3. SOCIAL COMMUNICATIONS





7. YOUTH MINISTRY PLANNER FOR THE IGNATIAN YEAR

IGNATIANA

This will be a weekend program for 2 to 3 days in Atmadarshan. It would be conducted every month or alternative months. We would take in every batch around 15 to 20 youth. We would focus on teaching the youth to take right decisions (discernment), the spirit of Magis, leadership skills. For this we will take the help of the Ignatian Spirituality Ministry also.

"KNOW THE JESUITS"

In our college, school and parish campuses, we shall prepare informative flex under the topic of 'Know the Jesuits'. It would be done regularly (alternative months). This can be used as part of the Annual Quiz, etc. (planned in the vocation promotion).

FIRST FRIDAY MASSES

The Youth Ministry is planning to take up the regular First Friday masses in St.Xavier's College and Patna Women's College. We would explain about the life, history, the saints of the SJ in these days. If need be, we shall prepare a small pamphlet containing the homily of the day.

RETREAT

The youth ministry shall arrange a Retreat for youth in October (Pooja holidays)

COMPETITION

We shall arrange one competition for youth (with AICUF) on the Ignatian theme, preferably in July in preparation for the feast.

IN NON-JESUITS SCHOOLS

In collaboration with the AICUF students, we shall design a program to bring awareness of Ignatian methods. The focus of this program would be the Non-Jesuits Schools and colleges (February and March 2022).


DRAMA

8. VOCATION PROMOTION APOSTOLATE

- 1. Video clips of 2 to 4minuteson life of St. Ignatian and life and mission of Jesuits to be sent to aspirants.
- 2. Giving talks of an hour or 45mts on Ignatian / Jesuit topics to Catholic School boys in Catholic Schools
- 3. Distributeamong youth leaflets and book marks on Ignatian themes and Jesuit life
- 4. We will have Quiz, essay and poem competitions for Parish and School for boys and girls twice in this year.



9. DIALOGUE MINISTRY

1 BODH GAYA-JEEVANSANGHAM: LAWRENCE EUCHARIST, SJ

 A 5-day special course training program for teachers integrating Buddhist way of attaining mindfulness with Ignatian spirituality.

AURANGABAD: FR. SAJI MATHEW, SJ

- Training-sessions for students to meditate, relax and examine themselves.
- Helping them through their value education classes to be good listeners.
- Scriptures from different religious traditions will be read out in daily assemblies
- Integrating harmony aspect in all yearly activities of the school.
- Conducting inter-religious prayer service twice in a year to promote peace and harmony (during Christmas)

3. BETTIAH, ST. XAVIER'S HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL: FR. RICHARD D'SOUZA SJ


- Inter-religious prayer service for important festivals like Deepawali, Christmas, and Eid
- Invite different religious leaders to address the senior students on interreligious harmony
- Organise Christmas Milan with the prominent people of Hindus and Muslims and local officials to build a cordial relationship with them.
- Organize competitions such as painting, poetry essay writing on the theme of interreligious harmony
- Visit the families of Hindus and Muslims if time permits.

4. BDVS/MANTHAN: FR. JOSE KARIAKATT, SJ

- Organise inter-faith meeting of heads of different religions
- Publish a booklet on Ignatian pedagogy for school students (suggested to XISR)
- Produce a documentary/video in collaboration with expert Jesuits/others on Jesuits in Dialogue in the last hundred years in Bihar.

5. AT PATNA: FR. JOSE KALAPURA, SJ

- Christmas Milan in December 2021 addressed by heads of different religions (conducted every year)
- Bring out a booklet in Hindi and English on Ignatius Loyola for use in schools/colleges
- Get a playwright to write nukkadnataks in Hindi on themes like peace, harmony and reconciliation, holistic development of students through education which integrate Ignatian themes such as "For the greater glory of God, for God and country, etc.
- If situation permits the same nukkadnataks will be conducted in various schools (as done in the previous years)
- Publish an academic article on "Ignatian praxis of reconciling contradictions in religious life, spirituality, human life and society".
- Organize a half-day seminar on peace and reconciliation highlighting Ignatian charism



10. ECOLOGY: TARUMITRA

- 1. Concrete steps for solid waste management of COVID 19 patients in collaboration with Government agencies by volunteers who have been associated with Tarumitra.
- 2. Biodiversity and steps to be taken to promote it.
- 3. Sustainable agricultural practices for marginal farmers.
- 4. Formation of Eco clubs by virtual contacts in schools and colleges.

8. FORMATION

COLLEGIANS, PHILOSOPHERS, REGENTS AND THEOLOGIANS:

- Prepare Video clips of 4 to 5 mts and share them with others. (at least 1 video clip.
- Write articles (essays/ stories/poems) on Ignatian themes for Sandesh (at least 1)
- Write a skit/play, evening prayers or compose songs (at least 1)
- Theologians will write reflections on Sunday readings linking them to Ignatian themes. (At least 1)
- A Play to be staged by Scholastics on the life and mission of St. Ignatius (May 2022)
