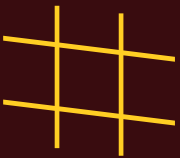

has been donated to Regional CRI (Conference of Religious India).

Online Counselling is provided to the people to generate awareness & how to utilise time with family in this crisis.

**Youth Empowering Service – Jesuits (YES-J)** one of the ministries of the Andhra Jesuit Province has started online Counseling for the people to support them emotionally & mentally, who are struggling during this outbreak at Vijayawada.

**390 families** of migrants, slum dwellers & poor people from various villages of Andhra are given dry rations which was distributed by Loyola Public School at Krishnapuram.

**Nutrition Support** provided to the police and poor people by Andhra Loyola College Alumni Association (ALCAA), Vijayawada.


**Hot Meals on the Wheels** feeding around 200 migrants, beggars and poor people.



**Accommodation** for 100 daily wage earners and migrants is made.

**A Farmer's Bazar** is created for the local public to buy vegetables from the merchants.
